Nasal Passages/sinuses (addition) Mucus may accumulate in and drip from the nostrils (runny nose) in these conditions. Infectious particles and allergens also impair cilia activity and can lead to symptoms such as a congested or runny nose. The thin walled veins on which the nasal mucosa rests function to warm air entering the respiratory passage. The sinuses lighten the skull or improve our voices, but their main function is to produce a mucus that moisturizes the inside of the nose. Lungs The main function of the lungs is the process of gas exchange called respiration (or breathing). In respiration, oxygen from incoming air enters the blood, and carbon dioxide, a waste gas from the metabolism, leaves the blood. A reduced lung function means that the ability of lungs to exchange gases is reduced.
